Adirondack Great Camp architecture.



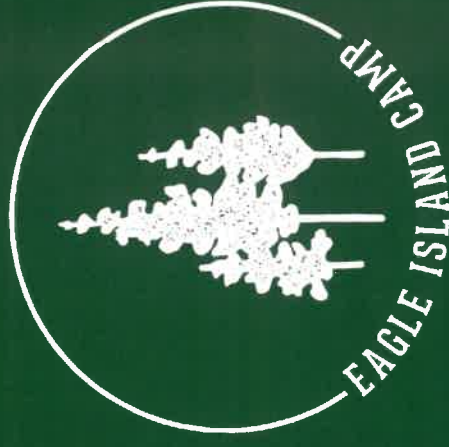

ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

Camper Sampler

(various ages depending on session) \$995

A perfect introduction to overnight camp, with a wide variety of camp activities. Improve your swimming skills and enjoy free swims. Try paddling a boat, make a friendship bracelet, discover what lives on our nature trails, or develop a new game with friends. \$995

Paddling Experience (ages 9–12) \$995

Learn new paddling skills while having fun with friends! Our skilled staff will teach you the techniques to confidently paddle all kinds of boats: kayaks, canoes, and corcls. You'll learn to move under your own power, and even maneuver your craft all the way around the Island!

Nature Explorers (ages 12–15) \$995

What sounds do loons make? Where do otters like to sleep? Explore Eagle Island and learn what makes the Adirondacks unique! Discover ecosystems and learn about mosses, mushrooms, insects, salamanders, and more!

Island Crafts (ages 9–12) \$1,045

Waterfront views will inspire your creativity as you paint, draw, color, craft, and more! What will your imagination create? Develop your artistic skills and dabble in new creative mediums. Includes a partnership with ADK ArtRise.

Water Adventurers (ages 9–12) \$995

Love the water? Immerse yourself in the fun and adventure of all the water activities Upper Saranac Lake has to offer! Experience the best of Eagle Island's waterfront with plenty of time for swimming and boating. You'll get to try out canoeing, kayaking, corcling, sailing, and more.

TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

Trailblazers (ages 9–12) \$1,990

Explore our unique Island nature and trails. You will learn the basics of navigation skills and how to pack and prepare for a hike with confidence. In the second week, participate in an off-Island trip to climb a nearby Adirondack mountain!

Finding the Wind (ages 10–12) \$2,090

Catch the Wind (ages 13–15)

Spend mornings sampling fun camp activities, and afternoons on Upper Saranac Lake sailing our Mercury sailboats! Specialized lessons from our skilled staff will teach you how the wind moves a boat and how to confidently rig and sail a small boat.

Note: In order to participate in this specialized program, you must pass the deep water swim assessment.*

Paddlers' Adventures (ages 13–15) \$2,040

Pathfinder Paddlers (ages 10–12)

Spend mornings sampling fun camp activities and afternoons paddling our kayaks and canoes. You'll learn different strokes and paddling maneuvers, and take an off-Island overnight canoe trip on the 8-mile-long Upper Saranac Lake.

Artists' Adventure (ages 11–14) \$2,040

Draw inspiration from our waterfront Island views in this session with an arts & crafts focus! Try watercolors, leaf pressing, birch bark creations, and more overlooking the Ampersand range. Includes a partnership with ADK ArtRise.
